ALL GROUPS

- Every individual who is interested in volunteering **MUST** complete a **Volunteer Registration Form or (sign up online) and sign a 2009 Volunteer Waiver** which will need to be returned to our office before volunteering on a job site.
- For each group that wishes to volunteer, there will need to be a **contact person**, who will be responsible to get the necessary paperwork completed for each member of the group. (You can print out additional copies from our website, or call the office to have additional copies sent).
- If for some reason you cannot come at your assigned time/day, please leave a message with the Volunteer Coordinator at 320-762-4255, so she can re-schedule a time for you/your group and fill your spot with other volunteers.
- We welcome groups of **no more than 10** people. (Group size may be less than 10 depending on build schedule).
- We accept groups with **youth ages 16 and older**.
- We commit to providing your group plenty of work. In the event of inclement weather, we will attempt to find alternate work or activities.
- **You do not need to bring your own tools**, we have plenty. If you wish to bring your own tools, you will be responsible for them. Please have them clearly marked.
- Please be sure to **dress weather appropriately**. Layered clothing is best for our changeable Minnesota temps. Mosquito spray and sunscreen are necessary in the summer. Rain wear is advised. Please bring a refillable water bottle for each member of your group to cut down on waste.
- **You will be responsible** for coordination of your own meals and lodging.
- As always, HFH is raising funds to build more homes. We encourage your group to **do at least one fundraiser prior** to your group work time. Don't be afraid to be creative!

YOUTH GROUPS (Youth is anyone between ages 16-18)

- We encourage a ratio of 1 adult to 4 youth.
- Accompanying adults are expected to actively assist with supervision of youth on the work site.
